



NISARG VIDNYAN MANDAL

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Nisarg Vidnyan Mandal (NiViM) is believing on self strength to acts in community. So, number of projects organized and run by NiViM are voluntary. Voluntary work and participation of members also strengthen the capacity of voluntary workers with support of local donations and CSR funds. Trainings and brain storming meetings at villages by participation of tribal community, forest dwellers and poor marginal farmers organised by NiViM at NETRAVAN. NiViM conducted overall developmental programs for the tribal belt of forest prone villages located on the fringe of Muniya Conservation Reserve (MCR) to avoid Man-Animal conflict and also followed the process of Forest Right Act-2006 (FRA-2006) to claim for the community forest right management (CFRM) from Sep-2021 to form a Community Forest Right Management Committees (CFRMC) through Gramsabha at pada/tanda/tola/villages to implementation of a sustainable agro-forestry practices for conservation of indigenous species of agriculture and forest plants .

Capacity building trainings of Community members & village level staff of line department :-

CSR fund received from LASNER INDIA(p)Ltd utilised as partial support to strengthen capacity of tribals, forest dwellers in the villages located on the fringe of MCR by filing an application to allot the land under Forest Right Act-2006 and rules -2008 through proper channel and sanction by district collector as a president of District level Committee under FRA. Land is allotted to community (Gramsabha) under rule -2008 and revised rule -2012 section (4) (1) (D) in Umrer taluka of :Nagpur .district. NiViM selected 45 Gramsabha villages from 15 Grampanchyat to form Community Forest Right Management Committees{CFRMC}. Thrust areas of overall development are Forest protection, Water shed management ,wildlife conservation, natural /organic farming for sustainable livelihood of marginal poor stakeholders of rural area. Social awareness and action programs and trainings of CFRMC executive members and staff of line departments are planed at NETRAVAN

Training's on implementation of FRA-2006 to form Community Forest Right Management Committees(CFRMC) and execute it to conservation of forest with security of livelihood of tribal and forest dwellers organized for executive members , Talathi, Forest guard and Gramsewak at NETRAVAN in two batch. Tenure of First batch on 3rd & 4th January 2023 and second batch on 9th & 10th January 2023. Mr.Chandrabhan Khandait, Sub Divisional Officer (SDO) Umred—Kuhi , Mr.Sandip Pundekar, Tahsildar, Umred were a chief guest.Mr.Dilip Gode, Executive Director,Vidarbh Nisarg Sanrakshan Sansth and Forest Right expert, Mr.Wasudeo Kulmethe, Rtd.DFO and Technical Officer, Tendu Sankalan process, Mr,Amit Kalaskar, Rtd.CCF were a subject expert for both scheduled trainings .Dr Vijay Ghugey President Nisarg Vidnyan coordinated the training's.

Total 9885 Hac land allotted to the Gramsabha of 45 villages in Umred taluk of Nagpur district.

Water Conservation (Chala Januya Nadila and Nadi Sanvad Yatra) :-

NiViM also promoted water shed management activities and s promoted a river AAM for the programme of Sanskrutik Mantralaya of Govt. Of Maharashtra under a campaign named as “ Chala Nadila Januya” .Survey of 15 villages located on the bank of AAM river carried out in association of revenue department. Under the chairmanship of District collector Nagpur. Nadi sanwad Yatra to understand the present condition of river ,encroachment on the bank of river. Also rally of students and villagers organised at Makardhokada, Sindivihiri, Jamgad, Khairee,,Amgaon villages of Umred taluk. Jal Kalash pujan organied at Sindivihiri on the bank of AAM river.

Rallies of school children, women members of SHG and villagers organized on the bank of village river AAM to understand the problems of water and resolve its by satisfactory solution.

Community Forest Right Management Committees Formation in Gramsabha under FRA-2006 : NiViM supported to allot a land to 87 villages in Umred taluk. Out of that CFRMC formed in 45 villages to work on conservation of water, soil, land and wildlife by participation of local community. To secure livelihood of local community a programme like collection of green leaves of Tendu implemented for tendu collection season 2023.

NiViM expert team visited in every village and organised a brain storming meeting cum Gramsabha in the morning and evening time as per convenience of villagers work situation. Most of the meetings organised in late night also. Out of 45 CFRMC formed in Gramsabhas of pada/tanda/Tola 40 CFRMC are active 21 CFRMC execute a business of green tendu leaves collection separately under guidance of NiViM. In FY 2022-23, these Gramsabhas generated income of Rs.5236890.00 only. This activity is not only generate income but also enhanced capacity of community business development and sense of belongingness of natural resources. Out total income 80% of the income after distribution of labour payment to families working for collection of green leaves. Remaining 10 amount credited to the account of CFRMC and Taluka Gramsabha Mahasangh (TGM) for expenditure of office berares TA, meetings and social work decided by committee members unanimously.

Residential training for members of CFRMC Gramsabha, Forest guard, Patwari and Gramsewak were organised on 3rd and 4th November 2022 at NETRAVAN . First batch of 62 participant from 18 villages and respective staff of line department participated in training .Mr.Chandrabhan Khamdait ,SDO Umred inaugurated the training .Mr.Sandip Pundekar, Tahsildar ,Umred,

Mr Dilip Gode ,Rxecutive Director,VNCS, Dr,Vijay Ghugey ,Founder Nisarg Vidnyan, Mr.Wasudeo Kulmethe, Rtd, DFO and Advisor ,Tendu Tendering Samiti Vidarbha Livelihood Forum. Central office of Umred Taluka Group of Gramsabha also to inaugurated

Expert team of NiViM regularly visiting to all villages to understand the process adoption by community members. All documents including daily diary,job cards and pass book for each tendu collection team member.Brain storming meetings at remaining villages Amgaon, Tambekhani ,Jambhlapni,Murzadi organized by NiViM to interact and inculcate the concept of wildlife conservation, Forest protection, need of natural farming. Dr.Vijay Ghugey,Mr. Wasudeo Mohadikar, Mr.Dipak Shahu (Social activist) were participated and share their views for management of natural resources by participation of community.

Man –Animal conflict solution by action of forest conservation :

After declaration of MCR to minimize or avoid Man-Animal conflict, NiViM decided to organized a Gramsabha in the villages to form a Community Forest Right Management committees (CFRMC) through Gramsewak for concern village/pada/tanda/tola of their Grampanchyat vicinity. As per Forest Right Act-2006 and rules -2008 and revised rule -2012 section (4) (1) (D). CFRMC formed during Sept -2021 to February-2022 by Nisarg Vidnyan Mandal(NiViM).

Positive impact of NiViM action and interaction with villagers as a member of CFRMC created positive approach towards wild life conservation. Result is a population of tiger and flagship species of biodiversity enhanced in MCR>

Wiped out from Muniya, tigers reclaim their land

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Nagpur: Sighting of a tigress with two cubs in Muniya Conservation Reserve (MCR) has brightened its chances to be upgraded as a wildlife sanctuary. A committee has already been set upon the matter.

On Saturday evening, one of the cubs was sighted by Kartik Madavi on the farm of two brothers, Avinash and Anil Sonawane, near Bendoli on the fringes of MCR.

"The presence of tigers underlines the importance of Muniya and calls for better protection and conservation works. Once a shooting block, the revival of tigers here is a positive sign," said Sonawane.

STRIPED SURPRISE

The 96sqkm Muniya was among 11 conservation reserves (CRs) announced on December 4, 2020, by the state wildlife board (SWBL).

The conservation reserve has been carved out from Butibori and North Umred forest ranges under Nagpur division. Of the 96sqkm area, 60.82sqkm is a reserve forest and 35.18sqkm is protected forest.

Though a final notification was issued on May 17, 2021, considering its strategic location and scientific importance, an SWBL sub-committee of experts has been set up to see whether Muniya can be declared a wildlife sanctuary.

Bharat Singh Hada, deputy conservator of forests (DyCF), said, "We will push for Muniya to be declared a sanctuary. The tigress with cubs has been sighted by passers-by, local farmers and shepherds for the past 15-20 days."

"Muniya will be a stepping stone for tigers in the future for its connectivity to Umred-Karhandla-Paoni Wildlife Sanctuary and Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve (TATR) and Bor," said Vijay Ghuge of Nisarga Vidnyan Mandal, who first initiated a proposal to declare the area a conservation reserve.

ACF Narendra Chanderwar confirmed that the tigress with two cubs was recorded in camera traps preying on cattle on March 2.

Progressive farmer Sonawane says, "Muniya being a shooting block, tigers have been wiped out from the area before the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 came into force. The tigers staging a comeback is a good sign."

Due to efforts of conservation at community level and its follow up with line department officers at district band division level Muniya Reserve Forest (MRF) presently notified as

Muniya Conservation Reserve (MCR)s level of protection is enhanced . Hence wild life migrated from MCR turned again in their ideal habitat and corridor for transist from one PA to other like BTR, PTR, TATR and UPKWL.
